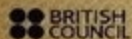

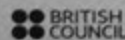

But also the fascinating you know filming, techniques that people used, it was a BBC documentary and you know they try to do it like a Hollywood movie and the way it is narrated and the way it is presented the story behind it and it started from seemingly middle of nowhere and somehow it piers make sense step by step, it was fascinating documentary and I really enjoy a lot and I learnt a lot about it as well.
